30 years ago, a young couple with a toddler left Dereham for S. E. Asia. Called by God to serve Him in Thailand, Andrew and Shona Goodman, with little Sophie, went with OMF International (Overseas Missionary Fellowship, formerly China Inland Mission) to serve among the Shan people in North West Thailand.

Over the years their family increased by another 3 children, and their ministry extended to include Shan people over the border in Myanmar, where they now lead a team of 40 OMF colleagues. Some members of the St. Nicholas church family have kept in touch, supporting them with prayer and encouraging them with gifts over these last 30 years. It will be a privilege and pleasure to welcome them and hear about their ministry next Sunday January 26th at the 9.30 service. There will be many newer people in our church family who will be meeting them for the first time, as well as those who remember them from the past.
